MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS PROJECT MANAGER'S OFFICE AND MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY

SUBJECT: Intent to Explore Opportunities for Collaboration between Unmanned Aircraft Systems Project Manager's (UAS-PM) Office and Middle Tennessee State University (MTSU)

- 1. Purpose: This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) documents the intent of UAS-PM and MTSU to explore opportunities for collaboration in the field of Unmanned Aircraft Systems.
- 2. Scope: It is intended to further the education of future American engineers, scientists, and other professionals to promote the development of the next generation of Unmanned Aircraft Systems.
- 3. Understandings:

UAS-PM will: Work with MTSU to explore opportunities, under existing law, to support the development of courses at the graduate and undergraduate level as well as research in the field of Unmanned Aircraft Systems.

MTSU will: In accordance with US arms control and export control restrictions (e.g. Arms Control Act, Export Administration Act, & International Traffic in Arms Regulation-ITAR), prohibit participation by foreign students, staff, and faculty members.

Each Party will coordinate with the other before making any news releases to the media.

4. Effective date: This MOU becomes effective upon signature by the respective parties.
